

# Transfer Money

You can easily move money between your eligible BMO Harris accounts and review your transaction history online. You can schedule one-time, recurring or future dated transfers.

1. Select the **Transfers** tab to view your scheduled transfers, completed transfers or all transfers.
2. Create a new transfer by selecting **Transfers > Transfer Center > Create Transfer**.
3. Select the accounts you want to transfer **From** and **To**.
4. Enter your **Transfer Amount**, **Start Date** and add a **Memo** (optional).<sup>1</sup>
5. Select the transfer to be either a **One Time Only** transfer or a **Recurring Transfer**. For a recurring transfer, choose the frequency of the transfer, the requested start date and the number of times the transfer is to occur.
6. Click **Preview** to review or edit your transfer before confirming.
7. Click **Submit**.

## Important

External transfers to another financial institution are not currently supported in BMO Harris Online Banking. To transfer or send money to another financial institution, you can add a **Biller** (formerly known as a payee in M&I Online Banking) within BMO Harris Bill Pay.

Also, you can no longer pay your M&I Credit Card using a **Transfer**. You must make credit card payments through BMO Harris Bill Pay or The BMO Harris Credit Card Online Access site at [bmoharris.com/cardaccess](http://bmoharris.com/cardaccess).

<sup>1</sup> Transfers made after 8 pm CT on any business day or any time on a non-business day will be posted on the next business day. Until it is posted, the transfer will be reflected in your available balance but will not cover any outstanding checks or debits presented for processing. Mortgage and closed-end loan payments take up to two days to display, even if they have already posted.
