How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. What we do	
How does BMO Delaware Trust Company protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does BMO Delaware Trust Company collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you: open an account seek advice about your investments tell us about your investment or retirement earnings enter into an investment advisory contract give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from affiliates and other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more information on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to you only unless you tell us otherwise.
Definitions	
Affiliate	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or non-financial companies. Our affiliates include financial companies with a Bank of Montreal or BMO name.
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. BMO Delaware Trust Company does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or service to you. Our joint marketing partners include credit card companies.

Other important information

For California Residents We will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of the BMO family of companies except with your authorization or as permitted by California law, such as to service your account. In addition, we will limit the sharing of information about you within the BMO family of companies to the extent required by California law.

For Vermont Residents: We will not disclose information about your creditworthiness to our affiliates and will not disclose your personal information, financial information, credit report, or health information to nonaffiliated third parties to market to you, other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
