The Bank of Montreal (the "Bank") issued a Prospectus dated 6 August 2021 (the "Prospectus") which is a base prospectus for the purposes of Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 (as amended, the "Prospectus Regulation"), which now forms part of domestic law by virtue of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018 (the "EUWA") (the "UK Prospectus Regulation"). This first supplement (the "First Supplement") constitutes a supplement in respect of the Prospectus for the purposes of Article 23 of the Prospectus Regulation and the UK Prospectus Regulation, and is prepared in connection with the U.S.\$32,000,000,000 Global Registered Covered Bond Program established by the Bank (the "Program") unconditionally and irrevocably guaranteed as to payments of interest and principal by BMO Covered Bond Guarantor Limited Partnership (the "Guarantor").

Terms defined in the Prospectus have the same meaning when used in this First Supplement. This First Supplement is supplemental to, and shall be read in conjunction with, the Prospectus and any other supplements to the Prospectus issued by the Bank from time to time.

Each of the Bank and the Guarantor accepts responsibility for the information contained in this First Supplement. To the best of the knowledge of each of the Bank and the Guarantor (having taken all reasonable care to ensure that such is the case), the information contained in this First Supplement is in accordance with the facts and does not omit anything likely to affect the import of such information.

THE COVERED BONDS HAVE NOT BEEN APPROVED OR DISAPPROVED BY CANADA MORTGAGE AND HOUSING CORPORATION ("CMHC") NOR HAS CMHC PASSED UPON THE ACCURACY OR ADEQUACY OF THE PROSPECTUS OR THIS FIRST SUPPLEMENT. THE COVERED BONDS ARE NEITHER INSURED NOR GUARANTEED BY CMHC OR THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA OR ANY OTHER AGENCY THEREOF.

1. Purpose of the First Supplement

The purpose of this First Supplement is (i) to incorporate by reference the Bank's comparative unaudited interim consolidated financial statements and management's discussion and analysis for the three month period ended 31 July 2021, as set out in the Bank's Third Quarter Report 2021, prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") and (ii) to include a new statement in respect of no material adverse change and significant change in the Prospectus and (iii) to incorporate by reference the investor report of the Guarantor with the calculation date of 31 July 2021 (the "July 2021 Investor Report").

2. July 2021 Investor Report

The Bank sold additional mortgage loans to the Guarantor on 29 July 2021 equalling approximately CAD\$3,270,000,000 in accordance with the terms of the Transaction Documents. This increase is reflected in the July 2021 Investor Report. The makeup of the Covered Bond Portfolio reflected in the July 2021 Investor Report is material and is therefore a significant new factor which is capable of affecting the assessment of the Covered Bonds under the Program.

3. Comparative Unaudited Interim Consolidated Financial Statements and Management's Discussion and Analysis as at and for the Three Month Period Ended 31 July 2021

On 24 August 2021, the Bank published its comparative unaudited interim consolidated financial statements for the three month period ended 31 July 2021 prepared in accordance with IFRS, together with management's discussion and analysis for the three month period ended 31 July 2021, set out on the cover page and pages 1 through 70 of the Bank's Third Quarter Report 2021. The remainder of the Bank's Third Quarter Report 2021 is not incorporated and is either covered elsewhere in the Prospectus or deemed not relevant to investors.

In accordance with Article 4.1 of Regulation (EC) 1060/2009 on Credit Rating Agencies (the "CRA Regulation"), please note that the Third Quarter Report 2021 contains references to credit ratings and information on pages 38 and 43.

None of Standard & Poor's Financial Services LLC ("S&P"), Moody's Investors Service, Inc. ("Moody's"), Fitch Ratings, Inc. ("Fitch") and DBRS Limited ("DBRS") (collectively, the "non-EU CRAs") is established in the European Union or has applied for registration under the EU CRA Regulation or is established in the UK or has applied for registration under the UK CRA Regulation. The ratings have been endorsed by each of S&P Global Ratings Europe Limited, Moody's Deutschland GmbH., Fitch Ratings Ireland Limited and DBRS Ratings GmbH (the "EU CRAs"), as applicable, which are affiliates of S&P, Moody's, Fitch and DBRS, respectively, in accordance with the CRA Regulation. Each EU CRA is established in the European Union and registered under the CRA Regulation. As such each EU CRA is included in the list of credit rating agencies published by the European Securities and Markets Authority (the "ESMA") on its website in accordance with the CRA Regulation. The ESMA has indicated that ratings issued in Canada which have been endorsed by an EU CRA may be used in the EU by the relevant market participants. The ratings have also been endorsed by S&P Global Ratings UK Limited, Moody's Investors Service Ltd, Fitch Ratings Ltd and DBRS Ratings Limited (the "UK CRAs"), as applicable, which are affiliates of S&P, Moody's, Fitch and DBRS, respectively. As such, each UK CRA is included in the list of credit rating agencies published by the FCA on its website in accordance with the UK CRA Regulation.

4. Documents Incorporated by Reference

A copy of the (a) the July 2021 Investor Report and (b) Bank's Third Quarter Report 2021 have been filed with the Financial Conduct Authority and, by virtue of this First Supplement, the July 2021 Investor Report and the cover page and pages 1 through 70 of the Bank's Third Quarter Report 2021 are incorporated in, and form part of, the Prospectus.

To the extent that any document or information incorporated by reference or attached to this First Supplement itself incorporates any other documents or information by reference therein, either expressly or implicitly, such other documents or information will not form part of this First Supplement for the purposes of the Prospectus Regulation and the UK Prospectus Regulation except where such other documents or information are specifically incorporated by reference or attached to this First Supplement.

5. No Material or Significant Change

Paragraph 4 under the heading "GENERAL INFORMATION" on page 309 of the Prospectus is deleted and replaced with the following:

"There has been no significant change in the financial performance or financial position of the Bank and its Subsidiaries taken as a whole since 31 July 2021, being the date of the most recent unaudited published interim consolidated financial statements of the Bank, and there has been no material adverse change in the prospects of the Bank and its Subsidiaries taken as a whole since 31 October 2020, being the date of the latest published audited consolidated financial statements of the Bank.

There has been no significant change in the financial performance or financial position of the Guarantor since it was established on 30 May 2013 and there has been no material adverse change in the prospects of the Guarantor since 30 May 2013."

6. General Information

To the extent that there is any inconsistency between (a) any statement in this First Supplement or any statement incorporated by reference into the Prospectus by way of this First Supplement and (b) any other statement in, or incorporated by reference in, the Prospectus, the statements in (a) above will prevail.

Save as disclosed in this First Supplement and any supplement to the Prospectus previously issued, no significant new factor, material mistake or inaccuracy relating to the information included in the Prospectus which is capable of affecting the assessment of Covered Bonds issued under the Program has arisen or been noted, as the case may be, since the publication of the Prospectus.
